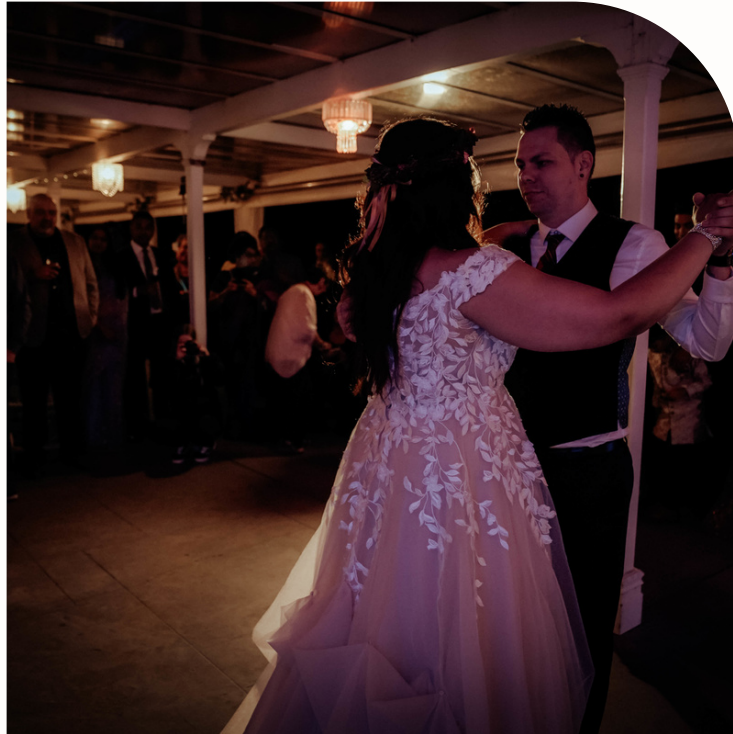


DJ & Live Musician Information Pack



So much to remember....



We hear you will be playing at the venue for one of our couples!

Welcome to Bridgewater Estate. This document is to help you understand the venue requirements as an external visitor attending and working at one of the upcoming weddings.

On Arrival



- If you are playing the music for the ceremony, please arrive no later than 30 minutes before ceremony to ensure you have enough time to be connected to the system.
- If you are playing the music for the reception only, please arrive no later than 30 minutes before the reception area opens to guests. Once the guests are in the reception area, you will struggle to get through all the tables easily, if you have a lot of gear to transport around.
- While we have Wifi available in Canapes Garden Bar and our Reception/Dance Floor, the wifi does not extend to the ceremony areas. Please ask for the password on arrival

Technology Available

- We have partnered with a sound engineering company to install DJ quality sound systems in all our spaces. These spaces include all our Ceremony Locations, Canapes Garden Bar and Reception and Dance Floor
- Our Ceremony and Canapes area operates using Bluetooth Technology so if you want to use our speaker system (to save you carrying gear around) please bring along technology that can operate on a Bluetooth compatible system. We would prefer you to not play around with our amp plugs etc
- For music in the reception space, you will need to bring your personal requirements such as Laptop, Mixing Station, Instruments (Including Mic Stand), DJ Desk/Table, Chairs (if required), Power Cords and adaptors. For Live Musicians, please note - NO SUBS as the noise carries further along the valley with a Sub

FOR DJS ONLY:

- We have a plug by the DJ area, that you plug into our amp and speaker system. Please note, we do not allow for external speakers and subs to be used at Bridgewater due to noise restrictions. (If you have played here before, this is new from January 2023).
- The plug box that your gear goes into via a cable is in the photo below as well as an example of the cable you need to supply.

- Under our Resource Consent from Auckland Council, we must adhere to noise restrictions. While our system allows us to monitor the volume and sound that is travelling to our boundary, our preference is to allow the DJ to control the volume, but if it goes over our boundary regulations, we will be forced to adjust volume from our system. We do boundary checks at 9pm and 10pm and need to be at 55db and 45db respectively.
- Our licence is set for a 12.00am close. Last song must be no later than 11.30pm but will be based on the schedule that your couple has given you. Please ensure you have the most up to date schedule (usually agreed around three weeks before the wedding)
- If you require a meal to be supplied at Bridgewater, please ensure you discuss this with the Bride and Groom prior to the event so they can arrange it with us.
