

TV Instruction Sheet

We have a 65 inch Philips TV on a trolley stand that can be wheeled around, that will be bought out to the reception area, if requested by our couple.

Please ensure that you have allocated the responsibility to someone in your wedding party such as the MC to organise connection, as our staff are not set up to do this.

We recomend to set up and test prior to the event starting (not prior to speeches) in case technical issues arise. This allows time to troubleshoot.



Connection Options




Casting

We have a casting device that can be used which needs to be requested. Justin Button (Owner) can ensure this is connected to the correct HDMI Port prior to the reception starting. Once connected, you will click the source button on remote and select the HDMI port. The sharing screen will appear and show instructions (As per picture) on how to connect depending on different devices such as Apple or Anroid etc. This option allows you to share from phone, tablets or laptops



HDMI Cable

One option is to bring your laptop and a HDMI Cable and connect directly through the HDMI Port. Please note that we do not have HDMI cables or adaptors to suite various laptop ports. This needs to be provided by you.



USB Drive

The TV has USB Ports and an app built into the TV which you are welcome to try. However we have had issues in the past with different format types where the USB drive has not been formatted to be compatiabile with a TV. Please remember the TV Is not a computer and cannot convert file types which is why this has been an issue in the past.
