The ratio is based on the items chosen and our experience on what is likely to be most popular</p> <p>Alternative Drop, Choice of 2 x each course. (\$130) This Means the Bride and Groom choose 2 x items for Entree and Mains in advance and we place them alternatively to the guest. The MC Will tell the guest this is what will happen and they are encourage to swap with the person next to them should they wish. This has been very common in Hotel Banquets for a long time and we are finding many of our couples are now choosing this as a way of savings some money. We find it loosens people up and can create a great atmosphere and point of discussion at each table</p> <p>Choice of 1x each course. (\$125) This is chosen by the Bride and Groom in advance and again is very common as it is more economical for them.</p>
